



# HELP KEEP BRIMFIELD CLEAN



## HOW CAN YOU PARTICIPATE:

By signing up to join others on helping to keep our roads / community free of trash! What better way to spend time with your family & Friends or better yet to meet your neighbor.

On Saturday, April 30th, 2022 from 8AM to 12PM residents are encouraged to get outdoors and pick up roadside litter in your neighborhood, stretch of woods, town common or any other open community areas.

The First Congregational Church of Brimfield will be the staging area where participants can get the following supplies and other information on the day of the activity.

- Gloves
- Masks
- Hand Sanitizer
- Safety Vests
- Non-Town Trash bags

Not only is litter unsightly, plastic litter especially, can be harmful to wildlife. Littered cans, glass and plastic bottles can be recycled, and residents are encouraged to keep them in a separate bag/container from other roadside litter.

Town Trash bags of litter may be placed out with your regular household trash for collection. All recyclables like glass, plastics and cardboard can go in household recycle bins for regular trash pick-up.

Any large items that cannot go into household trash like tires, bulky items, etc. place them in a pile on the side of the road. Call / Text (860) 595-4084 with the street address and location and a volunteer will be out to pick-up.
